Trends at a Glance

117.3 MILLION FORCIBLY DISPLACED WORLDWIDE¹

at the end of 2023 as a result of persecution, conflict, violence, human rights violations or events seriously disturbing public order.



75% HOSTED IN LOW-AND MIDDLE-INCOME COUNTRIES

Low- and middle-income countries hosted 75 per cent of the world's refugees and other people in need of international protection.⁵ The Least Developed Countries provided asylum to 21 per cent of the total.

69% HOSTED IN NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES

69 per cent of refugees and other people in need of international protection lived in countries neighbouring their countries of origin. 1_{IN}5 ARE DISPLACED

Relative to their national populations,⁶ the island of Aruba (1 in 5) and Lebanon (1 in 6) hosted the largest number of refugees and other people in need of international protection, followed by Montenegro (1 in 9), Curaçao (1 in 13) and Jordan (1 in 16).⁷
