# REMOTE WORKING IN ITALY

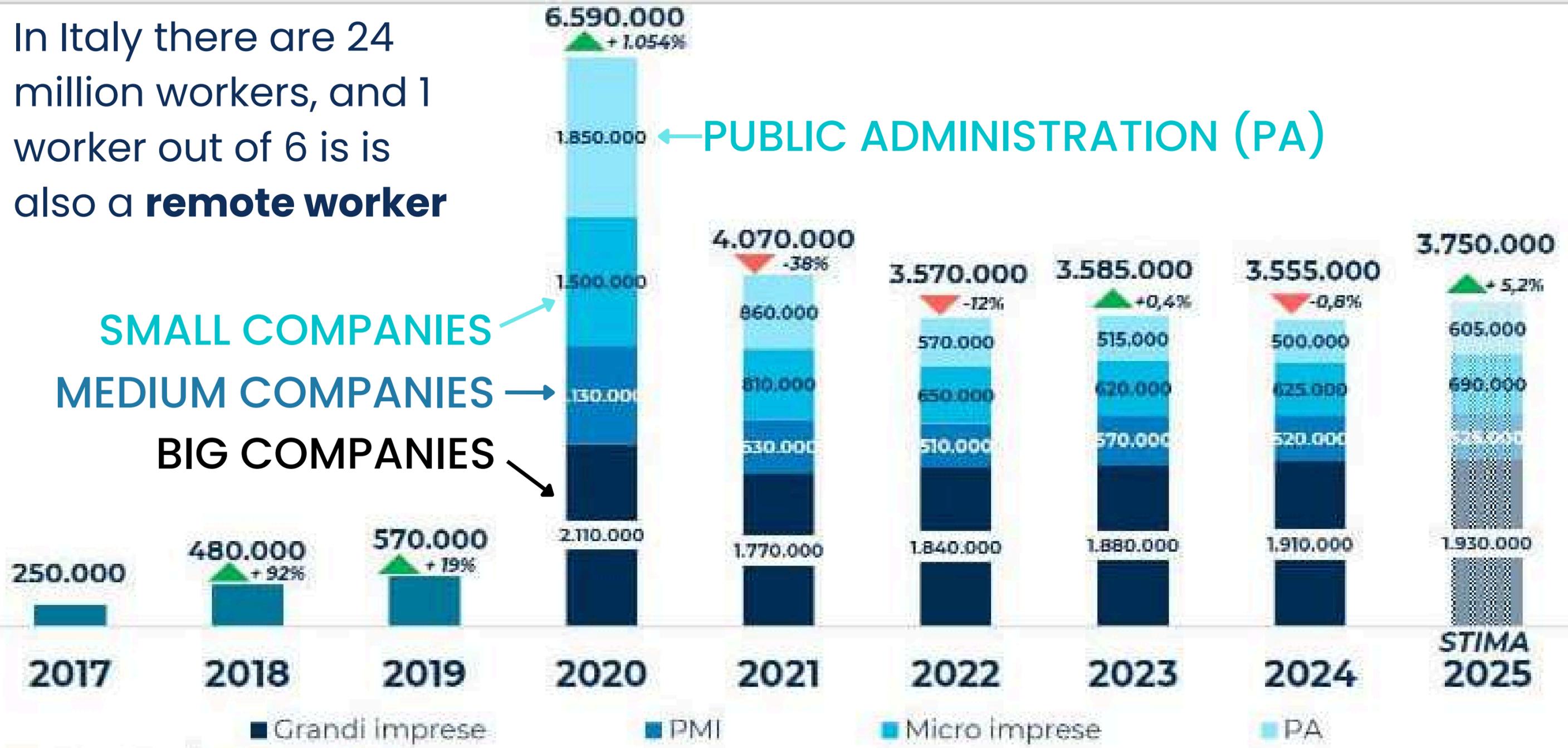
In Italy there are 24 million workers, and 1 worker out of 6 is also a **remote worker**

## ITS FOR REMOTE WORK

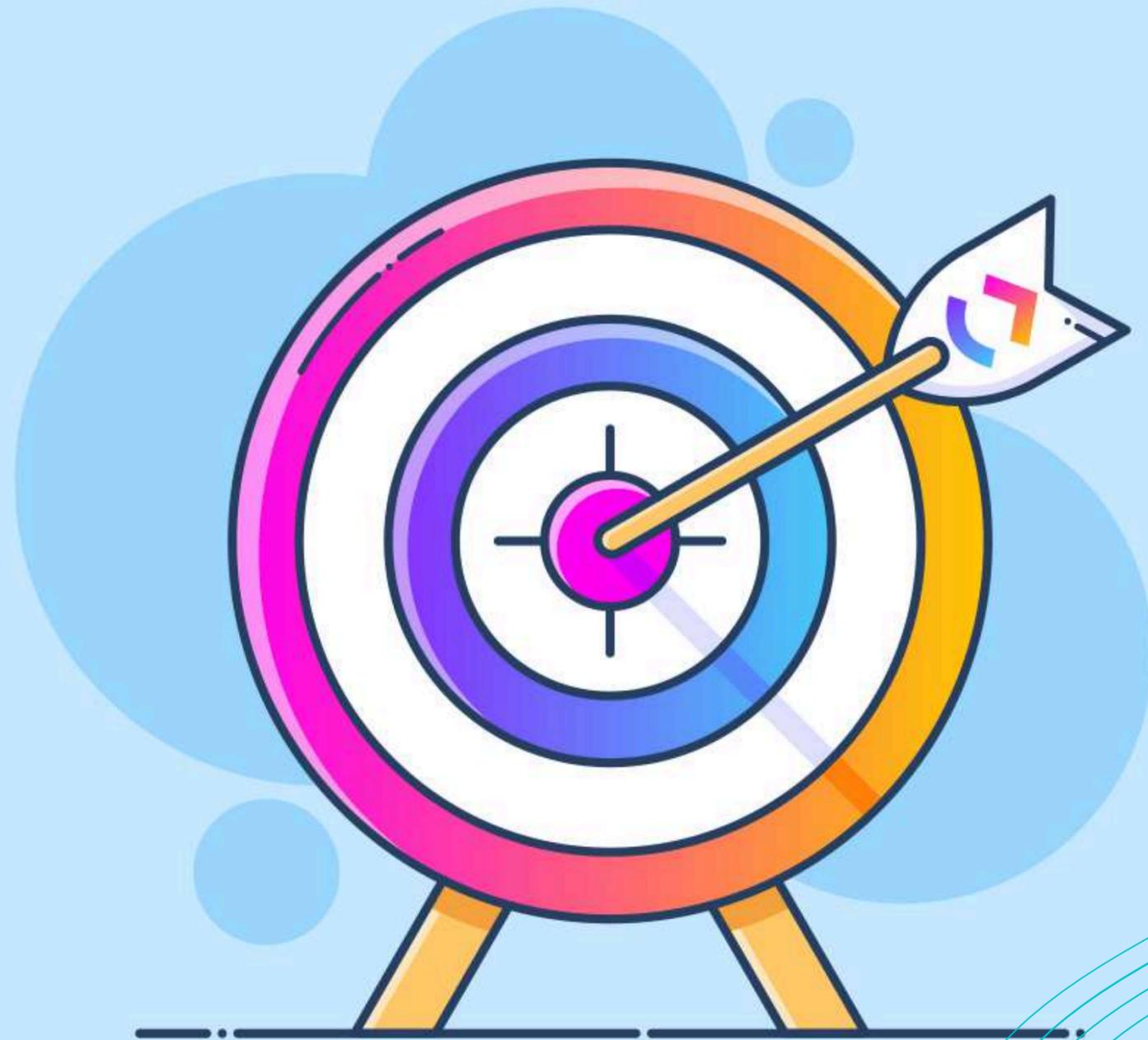
One of most important software for remote working is the **Virtual Private Network (VPN)**, that allows employees to connect to the server of their company **in a safe way** and simulating a connection from any country of the world

Thanks to VPN, you can also use many AI tools in advance, as they are usually released for USA first and for the rest of the world later

## SMART WORKING VS REMOTE WORKING

Remote working is just working from anywhere, while smart working is working from anywhere and for goals instead

This creates confusion in Italy, France and Spain where remote working is called smart working instead



## MAIN ISSUE

Who would like to spend 50-100€ a day to work, even if the place is beautiful?

That's why it is important to identify travel formulas tailored for remote workers, which have a lower budget than normal tourists but can travel longer



## LONG WEEKEND

The best travel formula is that of the long weekend in a town, coming back to the city on Monday or Tuesday

## MONTHLY STAY

Airbnb recently starting offering discounts of up to 50% for long stays of one month or more

## ACCOMMODATIONS

The maximum duration of a touristic rent in Italy is 30 days, after that the contract must be registered at the tax office ("Agenzia delle Entrate")

# COWORKING

If a town has many remote workers it can **requalify** an empty public building and open a **free public coworking space** to offer them an alternative to work alone

# COMMUNITY HUBS

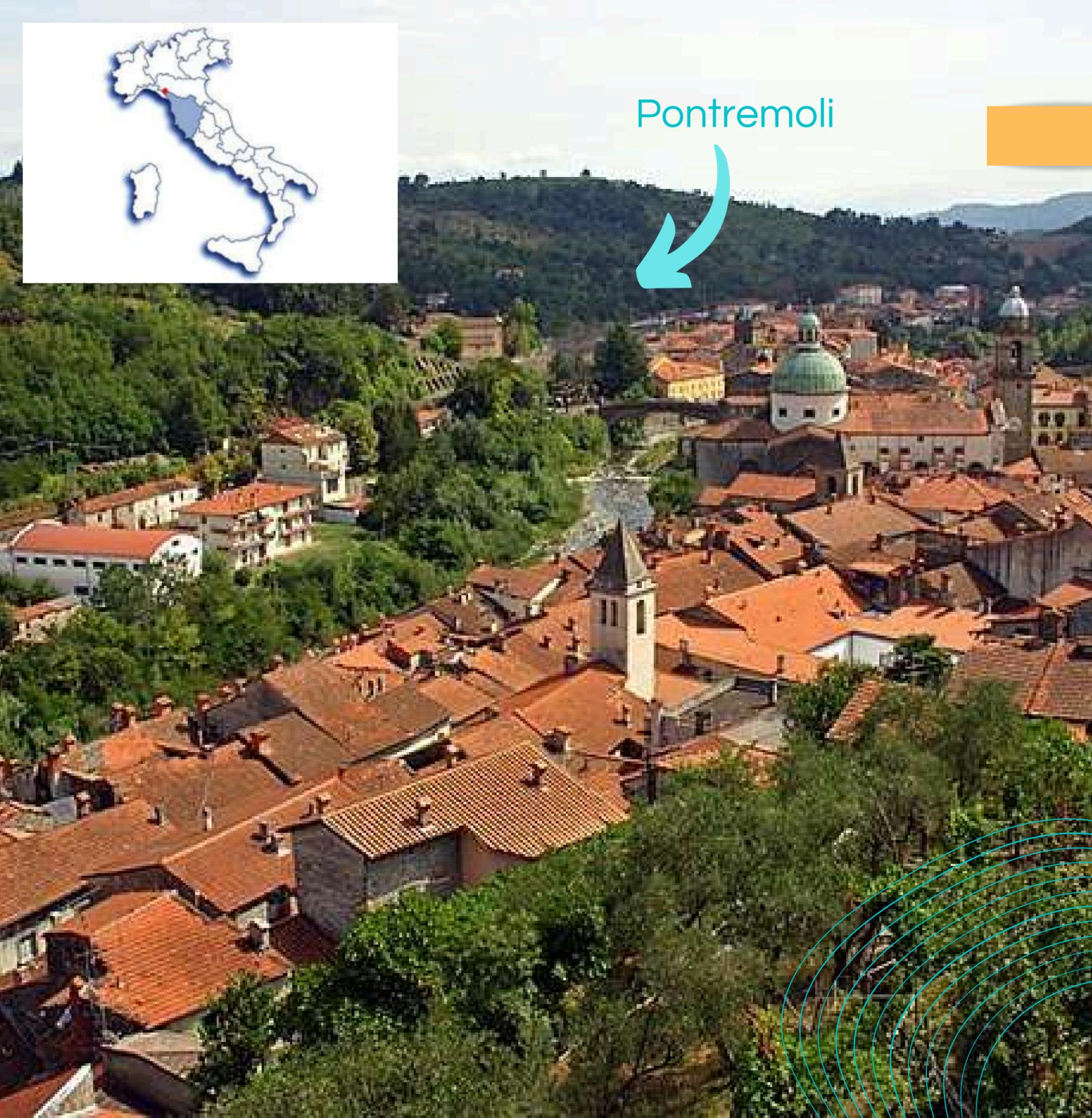
They are meeting points for both remote workers and town residents:

- workshops for artisans
- nursery
- conference hall
- library

## SUCCESS STORIES

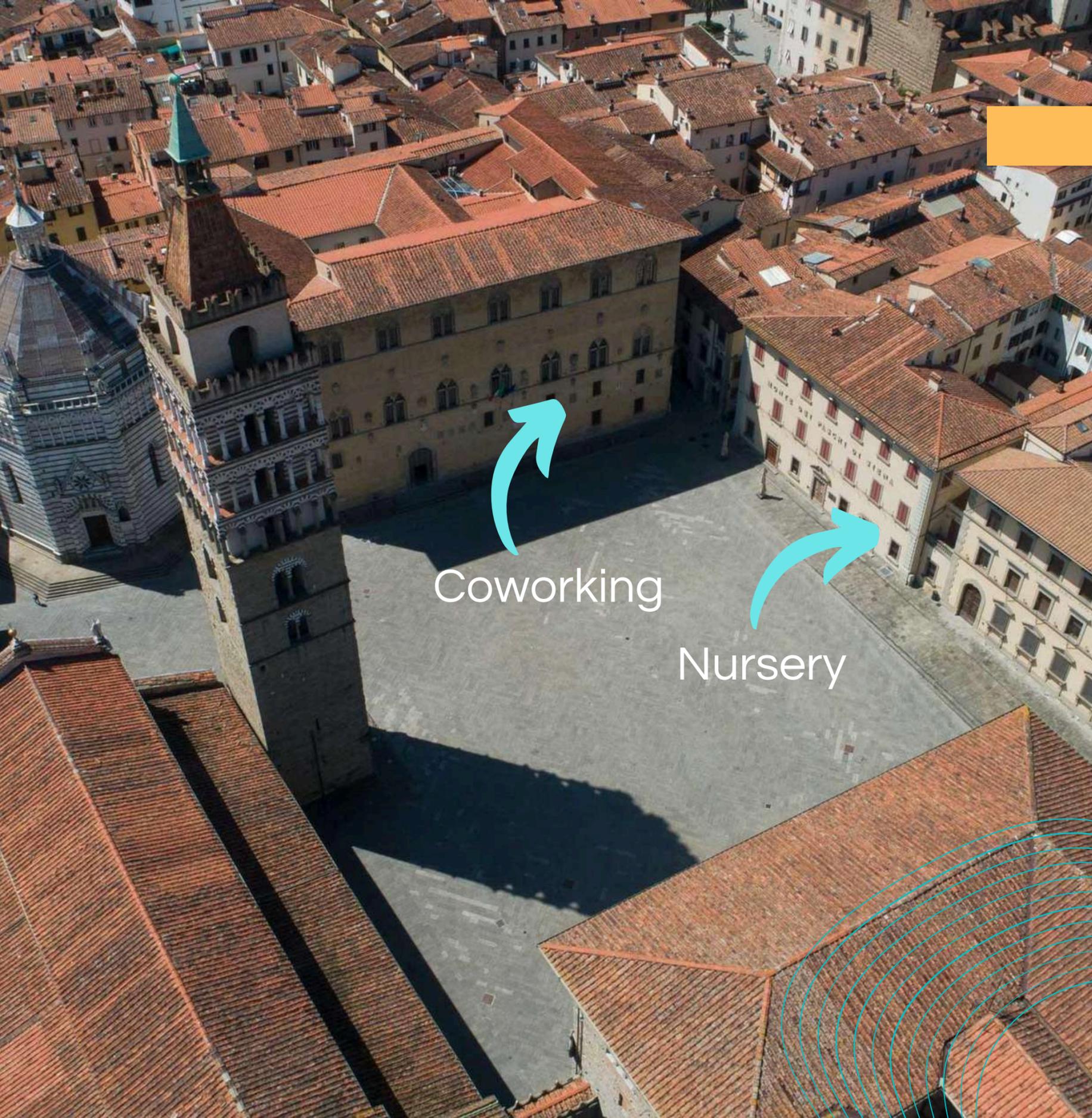
The town of Pontremoli (7000 people, Tuscany) 5 years ago launched a successful marketing campaign to attract remote workers and digital nomads

## SUCCESS STORIES

In a similar way, the nearby town of **Pistoia** also attracted digital nomads and even **families of digital nomads** (usually managers) from other countries that visit Tuscany for some months and work **nearby** the **nursery** of their children

## SUCCESS STORIES



All successful towns could count not only on a clever local administration but also on a supporting community

## SUCCESS STORIES

IT are not the main factor to attract tourists: it is much more important to have a good local community and a good local administration

## SECOND HOUSES

Almost 1 in 5 italians has a second house, for a total of 11 millions of people, but 40% of them are not used

## SECOND HOUSES

Workation from the second house is the cheapest travel formula for remote workers. They are finally able to spend more time in their second house (e.g: months instead of weeks)

## SECOND HOUSES

To facilitate their stayings even more, municipalities are now offer **free wifi connection**, so remote workers won't have to pay a subscription for it

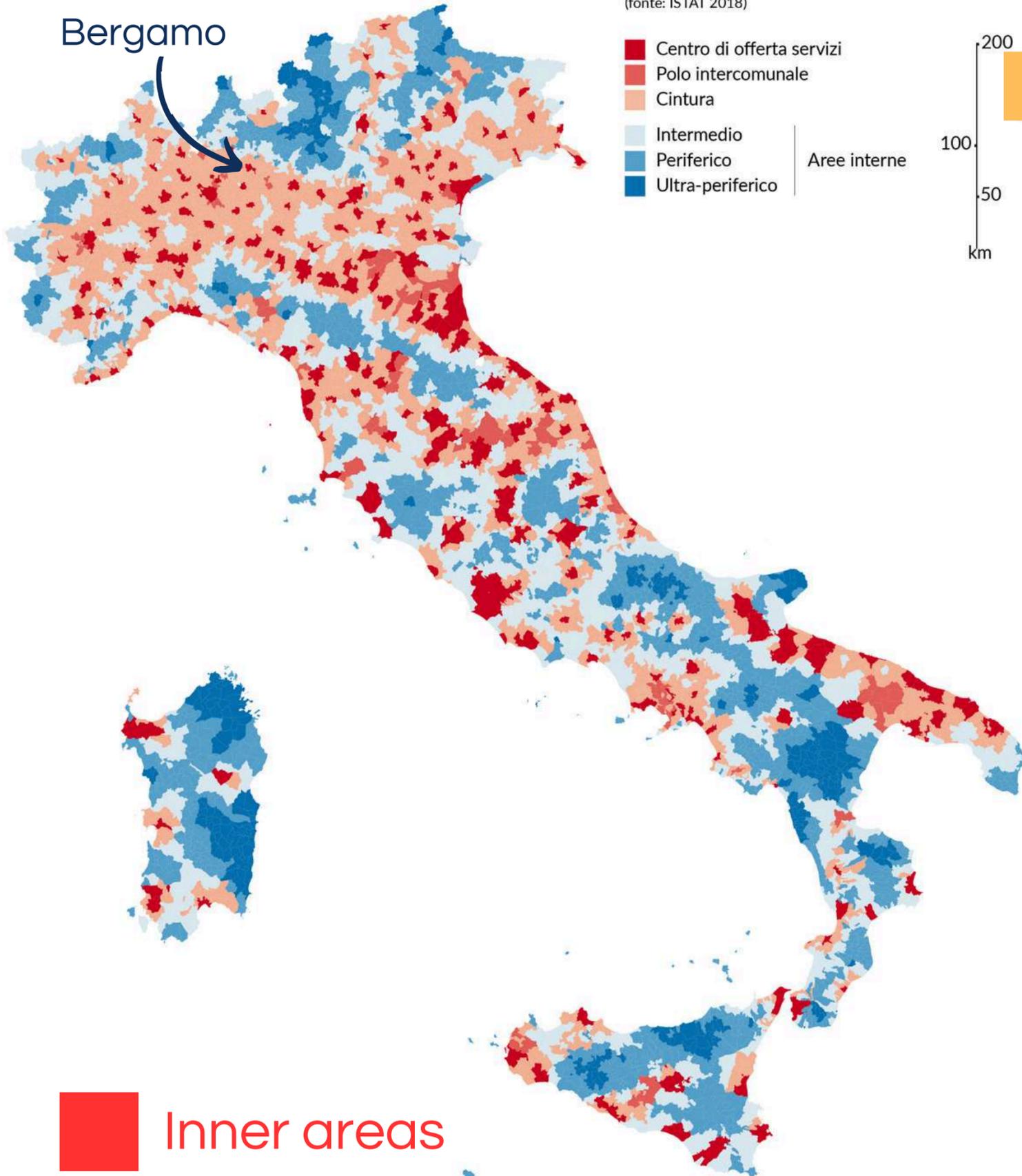
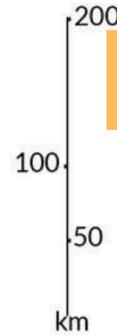


### CLASSIFICAZIONE AREE INTERNE

Map and dataset of mountain huts and accommodations ideal for remote workers:

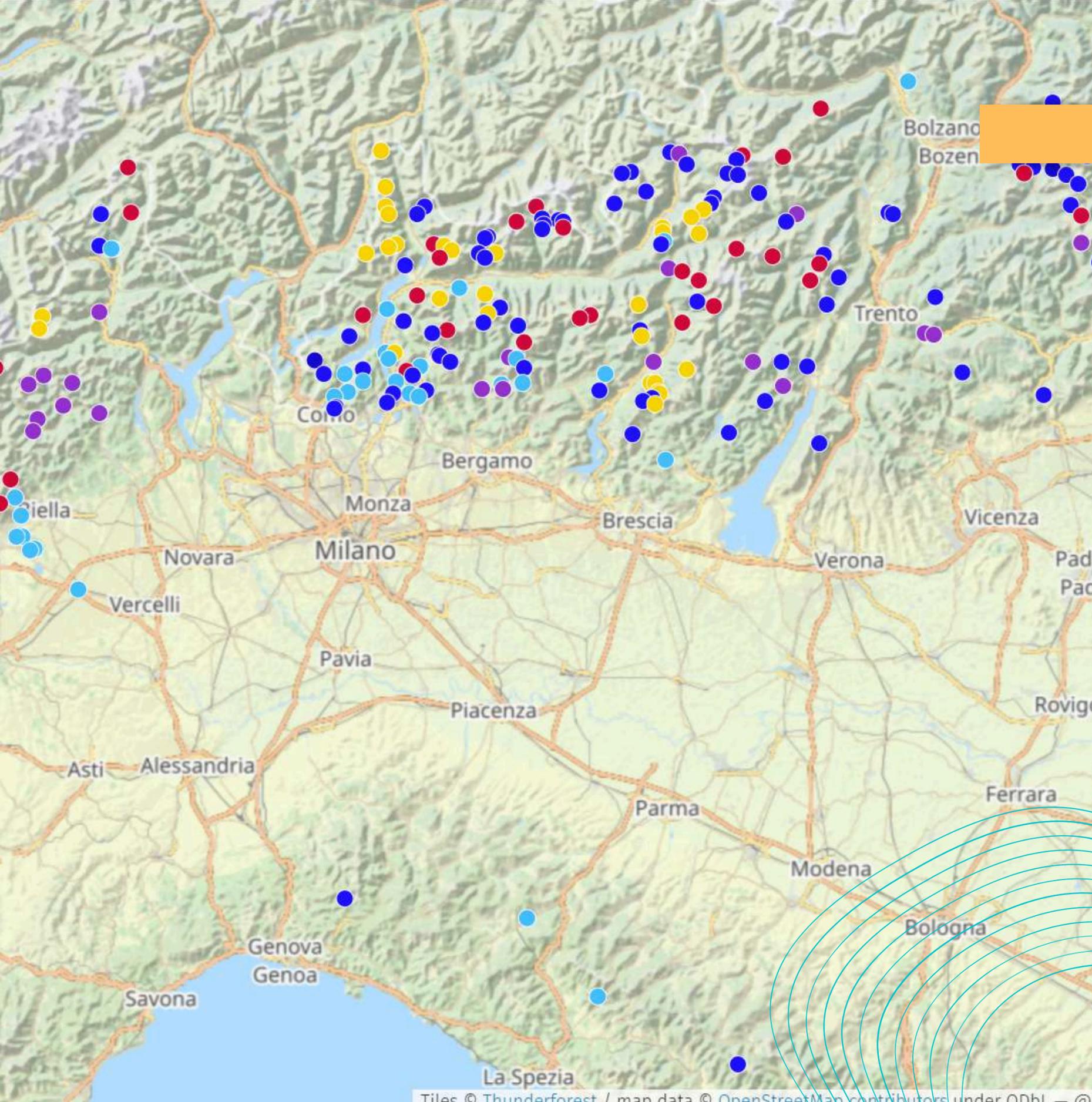

Blue points: huts close to roads

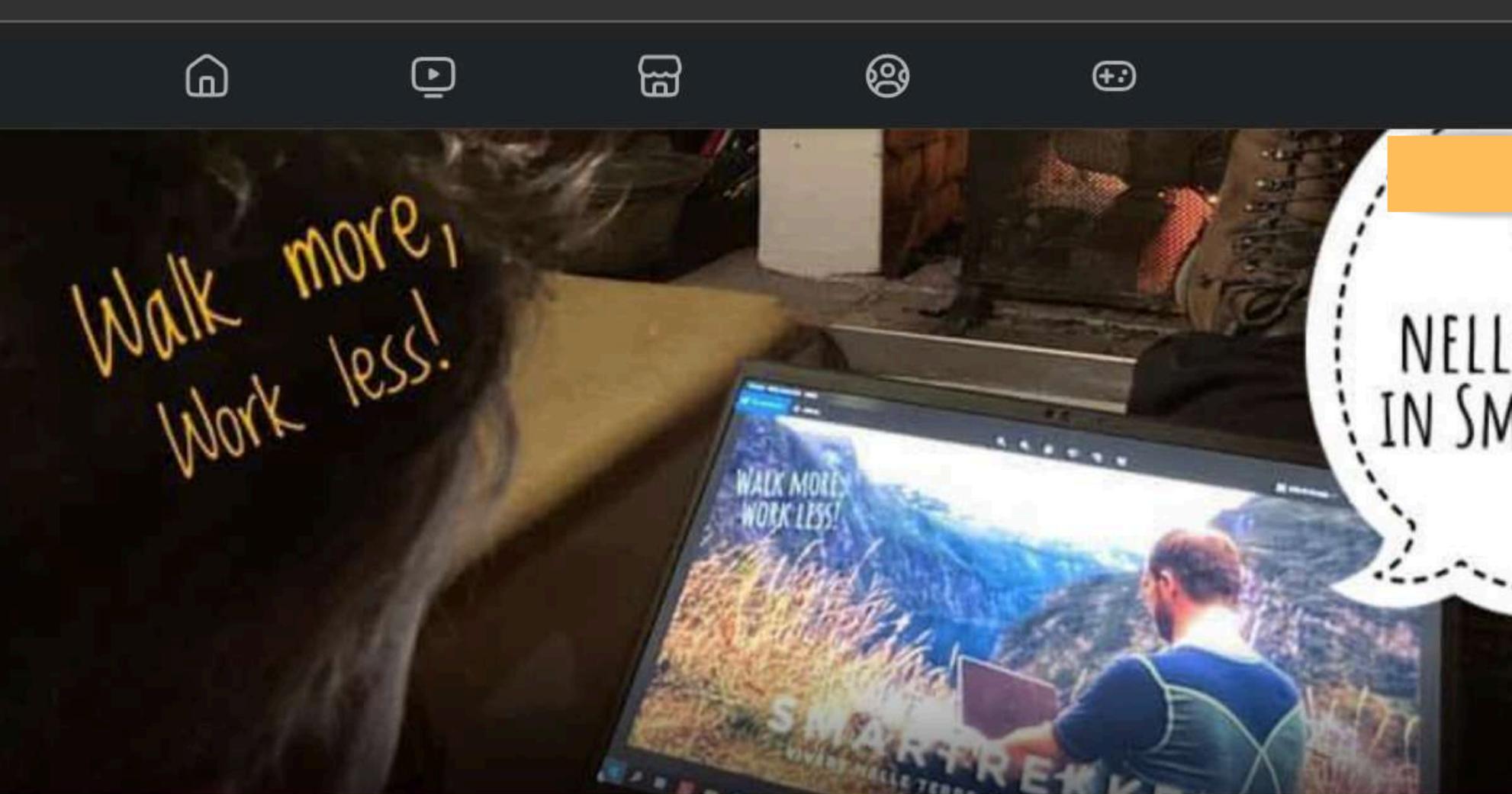
Yellow points: free huts

# TIKTOK SHORT VIDEOS WITH CANVA

How to make the short videos in each language:

1. Login to [Canva](https://www.canva.com) ([www.canva.com](https://www.canva.com))
2. Create your own copy of the “[Templates of Short Videos](#)”, also available in the Moodle: <https://www.canva.com/design/DAG1xnurUkM/s7oAwc91ZFHLP3ORCBiltg/edit>
3. Replace the citations #1-48 in the template with the translated versions in your channel language, taken from citations #1-48 of our [citation dataset](#). Replace the [author names](#) too
4. Change the [font](#), the [text color](#) and [format](#) of the citations as you like. Always use the same formatting in all videos.
5. Replace the [background video](#) of the ring of fire with another background of your choice (use the “Uploads” menu in the left part of the Canva window. Do not buy the premium license of Canva). Use a video that attracts attention. There are many videos available in Canva, but only to Premium users. However, you can create short videos of 8 seconds with Veo2, using [Google AI Studio](#)
6. Replace the [digital voices](#) of the template with other ones in your language. Alternate one video with a female voice and one with a male voice (choose the two you like more). You can use the voices available in the free version of [ElevenLabs](https://elevenlabs.io) (<https://elevenlabs.io>) or [TTSynth](https://ttsynth.com) (<https://ttsynth.com>), if you don't find any good voices in Elevenlabs.

## TIKTOK SHORT VIDEOS WITH CANVA

7. Replace the **background music** (the longest audio track at the bottom) with another one of your choice (not copyrighted). Both the background music and the video will be the same for all short videos.
8. Create one **Canva project** for each citation, as only Premium users can save projects with more than one video
9. When you have made the short video of the first travel citation, **create a copy the whole project**, rename it as "**spanish1**" (replace spanish with your language) and delete the other 47 videos, leaving only the first one
10. Download on your laptop the video of project 1 as an .mp4: "**spanish1.mp4**"
11. Copy project "spanish1" and rename it as "**spanish2**"
12. Make the video of the **second** travel citation and download it as "spanish2.mp4"
13. Repeat steps 11-12 to make the first **3 videos each**; try different styles and at the next lesson you will choose the best ones between all videos of the companions of your group
14. Create a **google drive** shared by all the members of your group and copy all your videos
17. Each **channel admin** has to invite me to the google drive too (by sharing at top right my email: nicola.cortesi@guest.unibg.it)
