




Why conduct a Profiling?

The Archdiocese of Capiz and the Social Action Center in collaboration with Caritas

The Three Basic Dimension (3D)



Three dimensional concepts are the foundation of a social action body:

<u>Identity, Structure and Context</u>. In ensuring its accountability, effectivity and contextual-based services towards the vulnerable groups, the church, in its social action, should strengthen these three basic dimensions.

Area Mapping / Profiling is one of the first steps of organization's sustainability in forming its identity and contextualizing their services for the future.

Context



Who are the vulnerable groups? why are they vulnerable? where are they? Who can help our services to help the poor community?

Caritas must possess basic knowledge on its own geographical area of working to understand the local context, in order to identify the most vulnerable people, and potential networks and foster local solidarity.





Objectives of the Profiling

- To provide a concrete picture of the situation of the communities, parishes and mission stations in the Archdiocese of Capiz
- To ensure accountability, affectivity and to identify contextual-based services towards the vulnerable groups
- To learn more on the archdiocese situation with the aim to address the identified problems and needs and to express with professional intervention on the love and message of the Church to the poorest of the poor



Consultation and Preparation Meetings

• Meeting with Bishop, Father Glenn, other Commissions Heads, Ms. Tin, and, profiling survey interviewers and CASAC team

Primary Data Collection

- **HH profile** survey 3,665 individual interviews in the all 16 municipalities & 1 city, 44 out 64 parishes, 225 barangays of the diocese
- FGD 92 participants from 35 Parishes
- Commission Heads Survey 13 out of 19 commissions
